


Bloomington-Normal Greenhouse Gas Inventory Update 2008-2015






emissions produced by all non-governmental sectors within Bloomington-Normal




Despite a population increase, B-N community emissions decreased 4.3% from 2008 to 2015









2015 Community Emissions



During this time period,
the widespread fracking of natural gas
resulted in reduced electricity emissions.
This was driven by the economic advantage
of cost effective and abundant natural gas
which increasingly replaced
the use of coal.
